He served as the bankruptcy trustee for Kiwi International Airlines and John Z. DeLorean. Simon is also registered as a mediator in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey.

He is a fellow of the American College of Bankruptcy and former Chair of both the Bankruptcy Law Section of the New Jersey State Bar Association and the Lawyers’ Advisory Committee to the New Jersey Bankruptcy Court. Mr. Kimmelman has been involved in a variety of charitable endeavors



and most recently served as President of Har Sinai Temple in Pennington, New Jersey. He also served as a long-time Member and Board Chair of the Woods Resources Board of Trustees.
